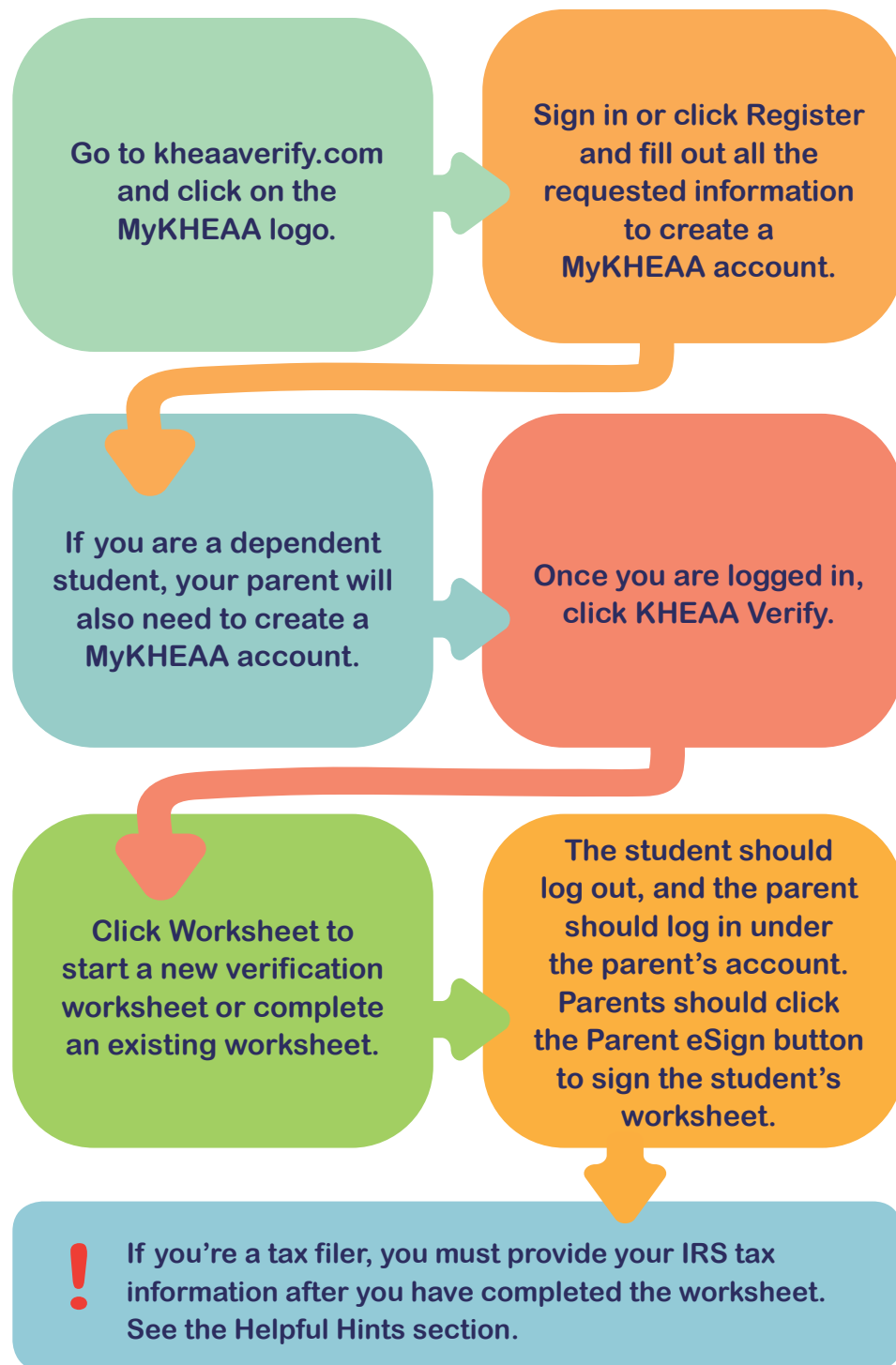


KHEAA Verify Process

Text VERIFY to 888-272-8771 if you prefer text messages.

The U.S. Department of Education requires some students to verify the information they submitted on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If you have been selected for verification, you **MUST** provide the information requested or you will **NOT** be eligible for state or federal aid.



The process above is for students at colleges or universities using the KHEAA Verify program.

Helpful Hints

- If you're a tax filer:
 - Use the **IRS Data Retrieval Tool** which will populate FAFSA's tax return questions.
 - OR —
 - Submit an IRS tax transcript if you do not, or cannot, use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool. Request a transcript at www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript or call 855-272-8771.
- If you're not required to file taxes, submit a copy of all your W-2's to document earnings.
- Login to your FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov at a later time if you need to make a correction or update your tax information.
- Complete all requested forms.
- Answer all questions, even if it is a "0."
- Provide all required signatures.
- Based on the documentation received, you may be required to submit additional information.
